

CMF to file charges against six applications offering loans for alleged usury

December 9, 2025 – The Financial Market Commission (CMF) alerts the public about six applications that are not supervised by the CMF and offer predatory loans.

The Commission filed a criminal complaint before the Public Prosecutor's Office against all parties responsible for the following applications, which are available for download from Google Play and other websites:

- APP PRETAMOS RAPIDOS - ALTA CUANTÍA
- APP RAPILUKA-PRETAMOS RAPIDOS
- APP GANAFACIL-PRETAMOS RAPIDOS
- APP INTI PRETAMO
- APP BANACREDI – PRETAMO RAPIDO
- APP SACO FACIL
