

## CMF issues amendment to regulation on lapsing of claims

*It sets forth that lapsed claims will be transferred in their own right to the Chilean National Fire Brigade Board, an adjustment derived from legal amendments.*

**August 19, 2026** — The Financial Market Commission (CMF) announces the issuance of Circular Letter No. 2374, which amends Chapter 2-13 of the Updated Compilation of Banking Regulations (RAN) and Circular Letter No. 1 for Payment Card Issuers.

These amendments state that funds belonging to lapsed claims will be transferred in their own right to the Chilean National Fire Brigade Board — which applies to both banks and non-banking payment card issuers. This ensures concordance with amendments introduced by Law No. 21,572 to Article 156 of the General Banking Act.
